### WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SALE

Due to COVID-19, the sale will be a little different this year.

On Friday July 31st, we will e-mail out the sale order program and a link to virtual bidding through Fair Entry. Please send an email to FCsalecommittee@gmail.com so we can make sure we have an accurate e-mail address for you and let us know if you plan to bid online, call in, or attend in person. This will enable us to order BBQ travs and ensure we have ample people available for phóne bids.

For those not comfortable attending the sale in person, you can bid online through Fair Entry until Saturday at 2pm or call 719-276-7390 from 10am-2pm on Saturday. Live bidding price will begin with the highest online/phone bid.

Buyer Check In and BBQ Dinner provided by P-Dubs Rolling Smoke House will begin at 4:30pm. Upon arrival at the live sale at Pathfinder Park, please go to the Sale Committee Table, register for your buyer number and pick up a sale order sheet.

Then you can go to the BBQ vendor to pick up your boxed dinner. At the stands entry, you will be given a seating assignment.

Due to gathering limits, we ask that only 2 persons per buver attend the sale. While at the sale, we ask that our buyers please wear face coverings and maintain 6 ft. social distancing. Due to gathering limits, buyers and 4-H/FFA members and families will not be allowed to interact this year. This allows us to count buyers as a separate group.

The sale order sheet will list:

- The 4-H member's name .
- The 4-H'ers animal number
- The animal's weight .
- The floor price, which is the buy-back price .

To bid on an animal, just get the attention of one of the ring men or the auctioneer. The highest bidder buys the animal.

## **OPTIONS OF PURCHASE**

Unfortunately, the sale committee will not be able to offer hauling of any livestock to the processors this year.

**Outright:** If you choose to keep the animal, you will be responsible for hauling the animal from the park after the sale. Animals not picked up immediately after the sale will be put on the buyback truck. Floor price amount will be deducted from your bid.

**Buy-back:** As a buyer, you may elect to consign your animal back to the Sale Committee for resale at an established price. As the buyer, you would only pay the difference between what you bid and what the animal brings at market price. Once you purchase the animal and it has been consigned to the Sale Committee, it cannot be given back to the exhibitor.

Buyback will be available for beef, swine, sheep and goats. For poultry buyers, buy back is not available and butchering is the responsibility of the buyer. Upon buying, declare if you will take the birds or send them home with the 4-H/FFA member.

\*Example: You pay the difference between your bid and the buy-back price.

Your bid:	\$300
Buy-back:	\$100
You Pay:	\$200

**Co-op:** Join another business in purchasing an animal by splitting the cost. With this option, you can still choose to take the animal home, or opt for buyback buy-back. This allows more animals to be purchased on any size budget.

Payment Options: The livestock sale committee will not be taking any payments on the night of the sale. A bill will be sent to you via email address and USPS. Please remit payment as soon as possible.

#### Rabbits will be a project only sale due to the RHD virus. A meat pen photo poster will be shown at sale.
