CERTIFICATION AND STATEMENT OF DISCLOSURE FOR MARKET ANIMALS “USDA WHOLESOME MEAT ACT”

The Fremont County Fair Board endorses and supports the USDA Wholesome Meat Act. The Fair Board also insists that all youth that are exhibiting market and/or breeding animal projects have complied with the 10 Good Production Practices listed below.

- * Identify and track all Treated Animals
- * Maintain Medication and Treatment Records
- * Properly Store, Label and Account for all Drug Products and Medicated Feeds
- * Obtain and Use Veterinary Prescription Drugs only based on a Valid Veterinarian/Client/Patient Relationship
- * Proper Administration Techniques and Withdrawal Times
- * Use Drug Residue Testing when Appropriate
- * Establish an Efficient and Effective Health Management Program
- * Provide Proper Animal Care
- * Follow Appropriate Feed Processor Procedures
- * Complete a Quality Assurance Checklist Annually

The member/family agrees and consents to abide by the rules of competition and will be in compliance with the proper, labeled use of medications and additives as required under the USDA Wholesome Meat Act.

I further understand that the use of any non-approved chemicals or improper use of approved chemicals is strictly prohibited.

No market animal will be allowed to weigh or exhibit at the Fremont County Fair that is within the withdrawal time of any medication. This form must be signed by the exhibitor and parent/guardian certifying that all animals are drug free.

Forms must be turned in:

Poultry – at check in on Tuesday, July 28th.

Beef, Goat, Sheep, and Swine at weigh in on Monday, July 27th.

By signing this form we certify that ALL of our market animals meet the “Wholesome Meat Animal Assurance Program” and are clear of all medications, drugs, pesticides or feed additives.
