Swine, Sheep, Goat and Bucket Calf Show

(Animal must be vet checked and on Fremont Fair County fairgrounds by 11a.m. July 30)

Friday July 30, 2021 – 12:00 p.m. in the Livestock Barn

Vet Check and check in Friday, July 30th 10:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m.

For kids between the ages 3 to 7 as of January 1, 2021 and currently living in Fremont County and a parent or legal guardian must be present.

Pee-Wee Bucket Calf Show

- 1. One calf per exhibitor.
- 2. Bucket calves are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the competition of the show.
- 3. Calves must be born on or after January 1, 2021.
- 4. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control and knowledge of the animal.

Pee-Wee Goat Show

- 1. One goat per exhibitor. May be shown with halter or collar. No intact males.
- 2. Goats not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the competition of the show.
- 3. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control and knowledge of the animal.

Pee-Wee Sheep Show

- 1. One sheep per exhibitor. May be shown with halter or collar. No intact males.
- 2. Sheep not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the competition of the show.
- 3. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control and knowledge of the animal.

Pee-Wee Swine Show

- 1. One swine per exhibitor. No sows or intact males.
- 2. Swine not entered in the Fremont County Fair are only allowed on the grounds for the duration of the show. Must be removed no later than one hour from the competition of the show.
- 3. Judging is based on overall grooming and handling, lead and control and knowledge of the animal.
