The Fremont County Cattlewomen Memorial Scholarship(s) provides financial assistance to a Fremont County boy or girl who comes from an Agricultural background such as family farming and ranching experiences in 4-H, FFA, community gardens etc. Students should be planning to attend an accredited university, college or trade school.

The applicant shall be a Fremont County graduating high school senior who can demonstrate through their application the value that their agricultural roots will bring to their future goals. College students may apply, but priority consideration will be given to high school seniors. A copy of current transcripts must be included in the application.

The applicant should describe in the narrative portion of the application their personal vision for how they will support the agriculture field upon graduation. Please feel free to include extra sheets as necessary. Each application shall include three (3) letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or an adult, not a family member, who knows your qualifications. Please provide only one letter from school personnel. The FCCW Scholarship Committee may choose to interview the applicants.

Scholarships will be awarded to qualified applicants throughout Fremont County. We are offering \$1,000.00 scholarship award.

Applications are available at the high schools in Canon City, Florence, and Cotopaxi; Fremont Extension Office, and from the Fremont County Cattlewomen web site, and the Scholarship Chairman. Please print out for final submission, and return it to the scholarship chairperson. Remember to include your current transcript and letters of recommendation.

The scholarship will be paid after the end of the first semester upon verified receipt of your grades which must be at least a "C" average. Include your plans for the following semester.
