Selection and Administrative Procedures:

- 1. Scholarship amount will be \$1000.00.
- 2. Applicant must be currently enrolled in Fremont County 4-H or a senior in high school who has completed their 4-H eligibility because of age. Applicant must have made a valuable contribution to the Fremont County 4-H program.
- 3. The applicant must have been a 4-H member in Fremont County for a minimum of 3 years.
- 4. Selection will be made without regard to race, color, creed, sex or national origin.
- 5. Applicants may attend a University, College, Technical or Trade School.
- 6. Preference will be given to applicants whose parents/guardians are involved in the farm, ranch or agricultural industry.
- 7. Full ride scholarship recipients are not eligible for this scholarship.
- 8. One or more scholarships may be awarded, depending on the quality and acceptability of applicants.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to not award scholarships in any given year.
- 10. The recipient must use the scholarship within one (1) year of the date scholarship was awarded. At the end of this one (1) year period any unused portion of this scholarship will become void.
- 11. Applications are due in the Fremont County Colorado State University Extension Office no later than April 3, 2025
- 12. A current transcript must be included with this application.

Payment of Scholarship(s):

Funds will be paid to the student as a reimbursement for costs incurred while attending the university, college, technical or trade school of his/her choice, for tuition, books, fees, meal tickets and/or on-campus housing during the one (1) year following the awarding of the scholarship.
