Check-in 8:30-9:30 a.m. by the show ring under the large pavilion.

The Pee-Wee Utility Goat show will start at 9:30 a.m. The Small Animal Show starts with rabbits at 10:00 a.m. followed by poultry. The Livestock Show starts with goats at 11:00 a.m. followed by sheep, swine, and finishing with bucket calf.

The Fremont County Fair is located at the Pathfinder Event Center in Florence.

Animals that will be brought from home must be vet checked during check-in between 8:30-9:30 a.m. Friday, July 31. A vet will be provided.

We will take entries on the day of the show if the participant is using a sheep, goat, utility goat, or pig that is currently at the fair and will not need a vet check.

For Kids between the ages 3 to 7 as of January 1, 2026, and currently living in Fremont county and a parent or legal guardian must be present.

Animals may be shown with a halter or collar.

Participants/Exhibitors are not eligible for the livestock sale.

Pen space is limited so animals may need to stay in your trailer until the time of the show.
